a permit application anywhere, at any time. You can start an application and finish it later, receive email updates on the status of your permit application and a record of permit documents will be retained under your online profile for future reference. Payments Made Easier

Property Taxes

You can now sign up for the Tax Installment Payment Plan (TIPP) any time. Monthly property tax payments are automatically withdrawn for your convenience, rather than a single annual payment in September. The City does not charge service fees or interest charges for this service. Contact the Tax Clerk at taxes@steinbach.ca or call 204.346.6531 for more information.

Water Bills

Pre-Authorization Plan (PAP) - quarterly water bill payments, automatically withdrawn, equal to the balance due on your quarterly utilities invoice. Deadline to sign up is two weeks prior to the next due date.

Online Utility Bill Services - receive your quarterly water bill by email and view your statement online.

Seasonal Construction Zones and Workers



Residents are asked to please use caution and obey all posted signs when traveling in or around the following construction zones this spring and summer:

- Sewer and water - Brandt Street from First Street to Lumber Avenue.
- Asphalt overlay - Penfeld Drive from half way between Appleton Place and PTH 12 going east to Golfview Crescent.
- Asphalt overlay - Park Road East from start of single lane section to Laing Gate.
- Overhead street lighting installation – from Chrysler Gate to Madison Drive

Please exercise caution when passing city employees completing line painting, asphalt patching, watering plants and trees, or other roadside duties this season. Thank you for respecting pylons and other safety signs set up for their protection.

Pet Clean-Up & Care
