## An Update to your Recycling Collection Services

*Please be advised that there will be changes to your recycling collection services.*

Recycling collection services will be provided by Bristol Hauling and will move to an automated cart-based system, starting **December 1st, 2022**.

All addresses will be receiving a recycling cart mid-November with a corresponding registration number. These carts are to remain with the property. If you move, you must leave the cart behind. The carts are the property of the City of Steinbach. Please remember that carts will not be in use for collection services until December 1st.

For replacement carts, please contact Eldon, Solid Waste Department Manager, at 204-346-6532.

Services will continue for residents who live in a multifamily complex who bring recycling to a large bin on the property. However, instead of using bags, we ask that residents place recycling in the bin loosely.

A letter and a pamphlet will be mailed out to all affected residents in November with more information regarding this change.

## Compost Accepted Year Round

The Community Compost Depot Program is over for the season, however the public is encouraged to still bring their organic waste to the compost pile at the Steinbach Landfill year-round, free of charge.



## Snow Clearing Tips

Winter is on its way and residents are responsible for ensuring boulevards, sidewalks and curbs are clear of objects and obstacles for snow clearing equipment.



Cars should not be parked on streets after snowfalls. Larger snow windrows (pile of snow that is left at the bottom of a driveway from the plow) will be cleared whenever possible. Please note that the ridge of snow left across driveways resulting from the clearing of sidewalks is not cleared by City crews. The City appreciates your cooperation!

## Payments Made Easier

**Pre-Authorization Plan (PAP)** - quarterly water bill payments, automatically withdrawn, equal to the balance due on your quarterly utility invoice. Deadline to sign up is two weeks prior to the next due date.

**Online Utility Bill Services** - receive your quarterly water bill by email and view your statement online.

**Tax Installment Payment Plan (TIPP)** - monthly property tax payments, automatically withdrawn for your convenience, rather than a single annual payment. Sign up at any time. To divide your payments over 12 months, sign up by mid-December 2022 for the 2023 tax year.

# Recovered Bikes

If your bike is missing, you can contact the City at 204-346-6211. A detailed description of the bike will be required, including a serial number and/or identifying characteristics (colour, features, defects, etc.). Photos of the bike may also be required. Missing bike descriptions are kept on file and checked against recovered bikes and owners are contacted if there is a match.



Found bikes can be brought to the City's Operations Building at 51 Millwork Drive.

All recovered bikes from the previous calendar year (recovered prior to January 1) that are not claimed, are allocated to the annual bike sale held each spring. Since 2019, the City has used local online auction services to sell recovered bikes. Information for the online auction is posted on the City's website as well as the City's social media channels at least two weeks prior to the start of the sale. Proceeds from bike sales are used for city recreational programming.
