BE PART OF STEINBACH'S LEAD SAMPLING PROGRAM



Starting in 2023, based on the Operating License guidelines provided by the Office of Drinking Water, the City of Steinbach will complete annual water sampling for lead at various properties across the City, and is currently looking for residents to volunteer their homes to be part of the water sampling process. Participation requires a one-time, 1-litre sample

to be collected by the resident directly from a drinking water tap on their premises. Sampling will take place between June and October. Please note that priority will be given to older homes and home daycares.


SNOWMOBILE BY-LAW
